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| <p>FC2601-03a</p> | <p>Public Participation – Suspension of Standing Orders Members were advised that members of the public had complied with the Council’s public participation policy to give advance notice to speak; however, this item had been omitted from the agenda. Resolved: That Standing Orders be suspended to allow members of the public to speak on items on the agenda. Vote: Unanimously agreed</p> |
| <p>FC2601-03b</p> | <p>Public Participation The Chair invited the following representatives to address the Council (up to five minutes each):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Simon Evans, Mumbles Rugby Club • Steffan Edwards, Mumbles Rugby Club • Michael Parkin, Mumbles Rangers Football Club <p>The Council received representations from Mumbles Rugby Club and Mumbles Rangers Football Club in support of proposals to reconfigure part of the Pavilion from a changing room into a multi-use function room. The clubs outlined that the change is supported for the following reasons:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Pavilion is increasingly required to serve multiple user groups, including sports clubs, community organisations, and the general public, and current internal layouts limit its effective use. • A function room would provide a shared, flexible space capable of supporting match-day hospitality, club meetings, community activities, and private or civic events, thereby increasing year-round utilisation of the facility. • Both clubs experience capacity constraints on match days, particularly for post-match hosting, families, volunteers, and visiting teams, which cannot be accommodated adequately within the existing layout. • The proposed reconfiguration would support financial sustainability by creating opportunities for additional income through events and bookings, helping to offset operating costs and reduce reliance on public subsidy. • The clubs highlighted that improved facilities would enhance the visitor and participant experience, support volunteer engagement, and strengthen Underhill’s role as a community hub. • It was noted that the proposal aligns with a collaborative approach between the Council and resident sports clubs, with both clubs expressing a willingness to engage constructively in future planning and development. <p>Members noted and thanked the clubs for their representations.</p> |



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| <p>FC2601-04</p> | <p>Consideration of the Draft Council Budget 2026/2027</p> <p>The Council noted that the draft budget had been circulated to Members in advance of the meeting, in line with the relevant legislative and governance requirements.</p> <p>The Chair advised that he and the Vice Chair had conducted a detailed review of the draft budget and had prepared a proposal identifying areas for cost savings. Members were informed that, while the Council has traditionally reviewed each budget line in detail, the approach presented differed from previous practice.</p> <p>As a result, a detailed discussion took place. Members acknowledged that the discussion was robust, reflecting differing views on the proposed approach.</p> <p>Following deliberation, it was proposed and seconded that the Council proceed to consider the budget proposal as tabled by the Chair.</p> <p>Councillor Rebecca Fogarty left the meeting while this item was initially discussed due to a declared interest. Councillor Fogarty later returned to the meeting to participate in discussions where she was able, before leaving again before the vote.</p> <p>A vote was then taken on the approval of the Council's budget for 2026/2027.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Votes in favour: 8• Votes against: 8 <p>As the vote was tied, the Chair exercised their casting vote in accordance with Standing Orders.</p> <p>Resolved:</p> <p>That the Council's budget for the 2026/2027 financial year, totalling £903,000, be approved.</p> <p>Precept 2026/2027</p> <p>In the same vote for agreeing the budget, the Council's precept for the 2026/2027 financial year was agreed, based on the approved budget.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Votes in favour: 8• Votes against: 8 <p>With the vote tied, the Chair again exercised their casting vote.</p> <p>Resolved:</p> <p>That the precept for the 2026/2027 financial year be set at £ 87.90.</p> |
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| <p>FC2601-05</p> | <p>Recommendation from Community and Social Development Committee – Flip the Streets Project</p> <p>Council considered a recommendation from the Community and Social Development Committee regarding the Flip the Streets Project.</p> <p>Due to technical difficulties, the accompanying video presentation could not be played during the meeting. Members were, however, talked through the Flip the Streets Project, which aims to address and reduce graffiti through a structured intervention approach.</p> <p>Members discussed the proposal and acknowledged the project's potential to address graffiti at the skate park and improve the local environment.</p> <p>Resolved: That the Council approve and proceed with participation in the Flip the Streets Project.</p> <p>Vote: Unanimously agreed.</p> |
| <p>FC2601-06</p> | <p>Exclusion of Press and Public</p> <p>Resolved: That, in accordance with the Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings) Act 1960, the press and public be excluded from the meeting for the following item due to the confidential nature of the business to be transacted.</p> <p>The recording was stopped.</p> |
| <p>FC2601-06a</p> | <p>Ostreme Centre – Door Repair (Delegated Authority)</p> <p>Members were reminded that this matter had previously been considered by Council, at which time three quotations for door repair works were presented but not approved.</p> <p>A further quotation was now presented, this time for the installation of a uPVC door. Members discussed the proposal and expressed concerns regarding the environmental impact of uPVC, noting that it would not align with the Council's sustainability objectives.</p> <p>Following discussion, it was proposed and seconded that authority be delegated to the Chief Officer to proceed with the door repair works on a like-for-like basis, expressly excluding the use of uPVC.</p> |



Resolved:

That delegated authority be granted to the Chief Officer to arrange the repair of the Ostreme Centre door on a like-for-like basis, and that the use of uPVC be excluded.
