		Alan Ferris has replied saying;
		In relation to Bethany Lane, the road is adopted as far as number 12 and we could look at introducing no waiting restrictions on this section. Can you advise on the precise nature of the problems being experienced to enable us to consider what solution may be most appropriate to address these? I would however advise, that should you wish to progress a TRO at this location then the costs for this will have to be met by the Community Council. As an outline estimate, assuming lining only, this is likely to be around £4,000 based on similar schemes elsewhere.

However, local residents objected to the proposals and this was dropped.
