C02506-05 To receive a presentation from Sara Holden - Sculpture by the Sea UK

The applicant for this grant application, Sara Holden joined the meeting at 6.35pm. At the invitation of the Chair, Cllr Thomas, Sara outlined key aspects from her written application before addressing questions from Councillors. Sara outlined that there will be six events at beaches along the Gower Coast although the funding requested would only contribute to the areas within MCC, Bracelet Bay and Blackpill. Sara outlined how in addition to the artistic contribution to the children's development the events incorporate nature learning into the programmes, in particular Sealife. Sara also outlined other funding and how these long-standing events required future planning and that changes to the programmes are not possible at short notice. The events are free to children with no restriction being placed on their place of residence. During the discussion that followed with Councillors it was suggested that this programme would be suitable for a three-year funding programme through SCC, which would provide greater security for the programme and assist with future planning.

RESOLVED; Cllr Fogarty to meet with applicant in the Autumn of 2025 to discuss a three-year funding programme.

RESOLVED that a grant of £2,175 be made to contribute towards the Beach Sculpture Festival 2025 and pre-festival children's workshops. Providing healthy mind and body activities.

Cllr Will Thomas thanked all Councillors, in particular Cllrs Marshall and O'Connor and Officers, notably Kerry and Claire for making MumblesFest 2025 the most successful yet, despite unfavourable weather.

Cllr Thomas was delighted to confirm that the application to redevelop The Mumbles Bowls Pavillion, made by Cllr O'Brien has been approved by SCC. A total of £60,000 is being made available for the refurbishment of the Pavillion with MCC providing £25,000.

Following the return of The Honour of Mumbles Award, Cllr Thomas wished to congratulate Rachel Matthews on her award which she recently received at MumblesFest. Cllr Thomas also wished to thank Rachel for her contribution to Mumbles.

Cllr Thomas provided an update on improvements to paths and roads within MCC including new surfaces on Mumbles Seafront and a number of 'drop kerbs' being installed.
