Cllr Thomas directed that whilst this question was outside the remit of the agenda, due to the connection with Armistice Day he would allow a brief update on the situation.

The CO explained that arrangements were in hand for the plinth to be permanently sited at the Ostreme Centre. This was arranged following the re-development of the seafront and in part through budgeting contingencies.

Mr Eames believed that the plinth should be sited on or near its original location at the seafront promenade.

RESOLVED Due to this item falling outside the agenda remit Cllr Thomas agreed to arrange a meeting with Mr Eames and relevant parties to resolve the issue at a later date.

Cllr Will Thomas provided a verbal update on significant events. This included Cllr Thomas' thanking staff for their continued commitment and contributing to a number of key projects that are nearing completion.

Cllr Thomas wished to thank both Claire Anderson and Elaine Wright who had recently left the employment of MCC. Claire had worked hard for many years bringing the community closer together through key projects and will leave a lasting legacy. Claire was also instrumental in managing COVID volunteers during the pandemic.

Elaine was the Ostreme Manager for ten years and contributed greatly to its success.

Cllr Thomas also welcomed a new member of staff, Hannah Hunter who is the Booking Officer.

Cllr Thomas referred to a number of developments in projects including those at Underhill Park and the Basketball Court at Langland Tennis Courts which have been outlined in his attached report.

Cllr Thomas stated how proud he had been to represent MCC at recent Remembrance Events and also thanked the Vice Chair, Cllr O'Neill for representing MCC at a Remembrance Event at Oystermouth Castle.

The Chair, Cllr Thomas requested that Cllr O'Connor, The Chair of the Culture, Tourism and Communication Committee set out the background to the recommendations of the committee meeting held on 22nd October 2025.

Christmas 2025

Cllr O'Brien outlined that following on from the success of the land train at Christmas in 2024 it was the consensus of the Culture Committee that a similar event should be held again in 2025. The cost of arranging a land train is £240 with additional expenditure required for children's selection chocolate boxes etc.

The cost of arranging a land train and additional expenditure to be paid for through delegated powers of CO and RFO. In addition, where necessary the cost of Christmas motifs and lights to be covered through same delegated powers.

Cllr O'Connor stated that the Culture Committee had sought recommendations proposing a joint or two separate parties for wards at Christmas. However, following consultation with other councillors she proposed a new recommendation, whereby each of the four wards would be allocated a set sum. Historically this has been the arrangement for each of the four wards to celebrate Christmas through parties

RECOMMENDED That each of the four wards has a separate budget of £750 for Christmas Parties

A discussion took place on the merits of having Councillors on selection panels. It was noted that a Personnel Committee exists and that the CO and RFO were qualified for selecting suitable candidates. However in relation to the forthcoming selection panel for the marketing officer some councillors have backgrounds that would assist in the selection process. In relation to the Marketing Officer the relationship with professional entertainers within the Culture Committee would assist with the 'events' aspect of the role. Full Council highlighted the need for candidates not to be overawed by too many panel members and that panel members should not be an acquaintance of any candidate.

RESOLVED That up to two committee members may be selected by the CO to sit in an advisory role during selection interviews. No councillor known to a candidate will be eligible to sit on a panel
