Budget Monitoring Report to 3/05/2024 - RFO, Paul Beynon Reports attached.

Financial reports prepared by RFO Paul Beynon had previously been provided to committee members. No questions relating to the budget reports had been provided either to CSO or The RFO prior to the meeting, and no questions were raised at the meeting.

CT2407-06 **Budget 2025/26**

The RFO had previously set out at Full Council the importance of a budgeting timetable for the remainder of the financial year, looking ahead through planning at committees and the early submission of budget proposal forms which will be re-circulated by The RFO in the near future. From September a clear indication of proposals should be established, with a view to a budget scrutiny meeting being held on 12th December 2024. A Special Meeting will take place in early 2025, with the 21st January 2025 being proposed, to agree the Precept and budget for the 2025/26 financial year, before being submitted to SCC for approval by 31/01/2024.

RESOLVED to approve the budget timetable 2024/25 and commence discussions on the budget at the September 2024 Committee meeting.

To agree £500 from the £2000.00 underspend identified in Mays meeting to support Cllr R Evans with hosting the Boarspit Bash.

A discussion took place in relation to the Boarspit Bash and Cllr Evans stated that this is an excellent cause for the local community to which all members of the committee agreed.

Essence of Mumbles Update

Cllrs Zhou outlined developments with marketing to start in early August, SA1 to assist in advertising the event through MCC Website. Preparations for advertising the event with a view to receiving applicants will need to be completed prior to the start of the School September Term.



It is proposed to start the competition/exhibition on Sunday 27th October 2024.

The original intention had been to host the event at a suitable location in each of the four wards within MCC, however Cllr Zhou stated that this would have cost (venue hiring) and staffing (volunteers needing to be in attendance) implications. The general consensus of the committee was that there should be one main venue for the whole of MCC, possibly Theo's (Methodist Church) with a preliminary viewing/selection process taking place at Ostreme.

Other formats including paintings were considered by the committee, but all members agreed that applications should be restricted to photographs. In addition, it was confirmed that all levels of photographers including professionals would be welcome to participate.

ACTION: Cllr Zhou to continue with the preparation for the event with marketing and venue issues to be addressed prior to September.

CT2407-09 **VE 80th Anniversary Celebrations**

A discussion took place on the importance of recognising such a significant landmark in the history of the country. The committee was in full agreement that the event should be marked within MCC, and options included a 'wartime' themed Coffee With Friends that would include appropriate films, singing and food.

ACTION: Cllr Hunter and other committee members to speak with suitable contacts to obtain ideas for September Meeting.
