CT2501-08 Baby Loss Awareness

Claire Anderson outlined how she had sought three quotes, and that Phillips had provided a quote of £718 for the purchase and installation of a light with multi-coloured functions outside Ostreme.

A discussion ensued on the cost of installing this lighting system.

ACTION; CSO to research cost of purchasing an alternative suitable lighting system together with cost of installing such a system by a qualified electrician.

Giant Mumbles Letters
