The Story of Mumbles

Bev Rogers the co-ordinator for The Story of Mumbles provided an update on The Story of Mumbles. Further volunteers had been recruited, and their role is now at full capacity. The work being undertaken is varied and includes the recent downloading of a 1950's scrapbook relating to The Mumbles RNLII, transferring 530 articles from John Powell's History of Mumbles Webite (22% competed), and memorabilia relating to The Gold Family. Other donations includes an anchor and memorabilia collections from throughout the South Wales Area.

Work completed includes the Mumbles Cricket Club and Newton Rangers Archives. There have been 72 contributors to date with 2.199 current items on the account.

The work of the project continues to be advertised through talks, including one recently to Probus and through social media, with 1,000 followers on Facebook and 195 followers on Instagram. In addition, there is a YouTube Account.

Coverage of the project's work will continue to be increased through participation at this year's Heritage Fair and a Railway Celebration
