

Subject: Question for Environmental meeting 25th April

Hi there

I wish to raise a question for the Mumbles Community Council meeting scheduled for the 25th April.

Last year the Mumbles Festival was fantastic and I am delighted to see from the recent meeting minutes this is being scheduled for 22 September this year.

However the absence of reusable cups for the bar was a notable disappointment. Many community event organisers are now using re-usable cups for their events to eliminate the use of single use plastic (as well as all the waste that is generated and needs cleaning us afterwards) eg [green goblet](#) . The scheme works by attendees paying for the reusable cup with their first drink but then getting 'deposit' back at the end when they return it. Often many folks do not return their cup (especially if there is a great image on it - competition idea?) and so this initiative often creates additional income from the event.

Can this committee liaise with whoever is organising this event this year to ensure reusable cups are used by at least the bar, thus noticeable reducing the environmental impact of this event?

I look forward to hearing back from you about this question.
