FI2311-03 Minutes of the Previous Meetings of the Committee

RESOLVED to approve the minutes of the meeting held on 16 October 2023 as a true record.

RESOLVED outstanding actions updated, details recorded in 'outstanding action' report.

RECOMMENDED that the revised quote received from Alain Thomas of £2,117.51 to undertake an evaluation of the outcomes arising from the recommendations made in his 2020 report to be funded from the Evaluation (FC6) budget be accepted.

FI2311-05 Budget Monitoring Report to 30/09/2023

Paul Beynon, The RFO, outlined the Budget Monitoring Report.

FI2311-06 Budget 2024/25 including presentation by Paul Beynon, RFO



Paul Beynon, The RFO, outlined current and future budgeting considerations including the need for budget proposal forms to be submitted in a timely manner. In answer to questions from Councillors The RFO confirmed that the training budget had been increased to £9,000 in 2023/24. In addition, the cost of preliminary work on The Ostreme Development was discussed and whether such work including surveys would be covered in the £250,000 proposed for the development from MCC's budget.

AGREED that all Budget Proposal Forms be provided to RFO before 1.12.23 in order that any proposal be agreed at December's Committee and discussed at the Budget Scrutiny meeting on 14.12.23.

AGREED that ongoing design team costs prior to development construction be discussed at Ostreme's Development Working Group.

AGREED that the attached budget for 2024/25 be recommended to Council at the Budget meeting to be held in January 2023

Whitestone Primary School Grant Application

Grant application for £4,000 to improve play yard areas.

The CSO, Ian Hughes outlined that he had e-mailed the applicant seeking clarification on the points raised at October's Meeting by Councillors but had not received a response.

ACTION: Cllr Erasmus be requested to contact the applicant for an update.

Heartbeat Trust UK Grant Application

Grant Application for £9,900 towards providing defibrillators in Mumbles 'Hotspots'.

The Chair, Cllr Scott outlined how he had met with applicant together with CSO following a request for additional information. The applicant had provided detailed information (previously provided to committee members) outlining current and proposed locations for defibrillators. The applicant stated that since the original application one of the proposed locations (promenade) had already been provided with a defibrillator by Swansea Council. In answer to questions both The Chair and CSO outlined how a number of organisations were contributing to the positioning of defibrillators. It was also confirmed that no other grant related to the current grant application in question. During the discussion it was also proposed removing the defibrillator from outside Ostreme to the Skatepark due to one already existing outside Mumbles Police Station thereby reducing the grant application to £8,250. Discussion also centred on MCC providing 100% of the cost in question but in the opinion of Councillors this was balanced against the overall expenditure of providing defibrillators together with free training also being provided,

RECOMMENDED: that a grant of £8,250 be provided for the installation of defibrillators within MCC Area from the Small and Medium Grants budget (FC1).

RECOMMENDED: that the defibrillator situated outside Ostreme Centre be re-located to the Skatepark as suggested by the applicant.

Mumbles Bowls Club Grant Application

Grant Application for £2,149.46 to assist in the payment of green maintenance charges.

The CSO outlined that in consultation with The Clerk and RFO he had not sought clarification from the applicant as requested by Councillors at October's Meeting believing that the points of contention had already been addressed in the original application. In answer to Councillors questions The CSO confirmed that the grant if approved would be distributed amongst the three groups using Mumbles Bowling Club facilities.

RECOMMENDED: that the grant of £2,149.46 for the maintenance of the Mumbles Bowls Green be provided from the Small and Medium Grants budget (FC1).



FI2311-11 **Sunshine Lotus Yoga Grant Application**

Grant Application for £2,400 to support yoga within the community through Yoga 4 Health

The CSO outlined how he had written to the applicant who had responded but that a further request for additional information had not been answered.

AGREED that the CSO will make further efforts to contact applicant and update the Committee at the December Meeting.

FI2311-12 **Oystermouth Panto Grant Application**

Grant Application for an amount up to £2,000 to assist in relation to a Christmas Panto.

The Chair, Cllr Scott and CSO outlined that the applicant had not responded to the CSO's request for additional information. In addition the Ostreme's Centre Manager had been consulted and a booking would not now be possible in any event at such short notice before Christmas.

RESOLVED that the application should be rejected.

FI2311-13 **Mumbles Rugby Club Grant Application**

Grant Application for £2,000 to contribute towards the community-based annual festival.

The CSO updated the committee on his contact with applicant. Following his initial request for information the applicant e-mailed some details but was unable to provide a further update due to being on holiday in Mexico. The applicant will be contacting CSO upon his return from holiday.

AGREED that the CSO will provide a further update at the December Meeting.

Amlinellodd y Cadeirydd, y Cynghorydd Scott, sut yr oedd wedi cyfarfod â'r ymgeisydd ynghyd â'r Swyddog Cymorth Pwyllgorau yn dilyn cais am wybodaeth ychwanegol. Roedd yr ymgeisydd wedi darparu gwybodaeth fanwl (a ddarparwyd yn flaenorol i aelodau'r pwyllgor) yn amlinellu lleoliadau presennol ac arfaethedig ar gyfer diffibrilwyr. Dywedodd yr ymgeisydd ers y cais gwreiddiol fod un o'r lleoliadau arfaethedig (y promenâd) eisoes wedi cael diffibriliwr gan Gyngor Dinas a Sir Abertawe. Mewn ymateb i gwestiynau, amlinellodd y Cadeirydd a'r Swyddog Cymorth Pwyllgorau sut yr oedd nifer o sefydliadau yn cyfrannu at leoli diffibrilwyr. Cadarnhawyd hefyd nad oedd unrhyw grant arall yn ymwneud â'r cais grant presennol dan sylw.
