FI2510-07**Internal Audit 2025/26 - Recommendations Tracker**

The RFO had distributed a detailed internal audit of recommendations made following a review. The RFO detailed that each recommendation had been colour coded with red indicating that the recommendation had yet to be initiated, amber indicating that the recommendation was in progress and green indicating that the recommendation had been completed.

The RFO went through each of the recommendations and invited the Committee to raise questions.

Where the RFO has disagreed with the authors' recommendations, this has been recorded in the minutes of the Full Council Meeting held on 14th October 2025.

In answer to how frequently the recommendations will be scrutinised, the RFO proposed that progress be reviewed every two months by committee.

RESOLVED That the progress of the recommendations be reviewed by committee every two months with the first review taking place in January 2026 to take into account the Christmas Holiday.

**FI2510-08****Mumbles Traders Grant Application**

Grant Application for £2,300 to contribute towards the Annual Mumbles Christmas Parade.

In answer to a query raised by The Chair, (Cllr Marshall), the RFO informed The Committee that MCC had still not received all the relevant information sought in relation to this and other grant applications. In particular details of expenditure and full bank statements. For example MCC would expect to receive expenditure showing that SCC had been paid for road closures for relevant events and that The RNLI had been paid for Christmas events.

The Committee was mindful that Christmas events are important for the community but needed to ensure that the correct procedures were followed and that MCC will not exposed to adverse criticism if independently scrutinised.

Whilst the grant applicant had suggested that MCC could pay for some services directly when contributing to events (e.g. paying SCC for road closures) this would not be possible due to MCC then having their name attributed to the event.

RECOMMENDED that a grant application for £2,300 be awarded to Mumbles Traders to contribute towards the Annual Mumbles Christmas Parade 2025 be approved subject to the RFO receiving full information as previously requested prior to November's Full Council Meeting.

Unless this information is received including itemised costs the grant will not be paid

FI2510-09**Mumbles Traders Grant Application**

Grant Application for £2,715 to contribute towards installation of 53 Christmas Trees & lights in Newton Road, Mumbles.

The issues connected to this application are similar to those detailed in the previous application [FI2510-08](#). Again, whilst MCC are enthusiastic for the Christmas Trees and lights to be installed, this cannot be granted at the expense of compromising the regulations under which MCC provides grants.

Unless this information is received including itemised costs the grant will not be paid.
