The Bee Friendly Streets project is a pilot project launched this year in West Cross and Mayals. We are minimizing the use of harmful chemical weedkillers and pesticides to safeguard our precious pollinators.

Embracing a hands-on approach, we are using selective manual weeding, complemented by engaging weeding volunteer days.

The young ambassadors for nature at Ysgol Llwynderw supported us with an informative video series, highlighting the hidden wonders of urban wildflowers.
